¹ Days are reckoned as beginning on the first date at sundown and ending on the second date at sundown. The scriptural new year begins with the new moon of Abib from Jerusalem as stated in Isaiah 2:3, "... for out of Zion will the law go forth, and the word of Yahweh from Jerusalem." The new moon can be predetermined as per examples in 1 Sam., 20:5 & 18. Note Abib 1 is the beginning of Year 15 of the 70th Jubilee cycle calculated from the time that the Israelites observed the first Jubilee cycle in 1386/1385 B.C.E.

² Passover Day begins on the fourteenth day of Abib and is the first of seven days of Unleavened Bread and the Festival of Passover. Ex. 12:6–20, 13:3–10, 34:18; Lev. 23:5, 23:7; Num. 9:2–3, 28:16–25; Deut. 16:1–4, Ezekiel 45:21; Matt. 26:17; Mark 14:12; Luke 22:7.

³ Second festival day of Unleavened Bread and Passover Week. Not a High Sabbath or Holy Convocation. Lev. 23:6; Num. 28:16–25, 33:3–4.

⁴ The day after the weekly Sabbath of Passover Week. Lev. 23:9–11. Not a Festival, High Sabbath. Listed to determine date of Festival of Weeks.

⁵ Seventh festival day of Unleavened Bread and Passover Week. Ex. 12:16, 13:6–7; Lev. 23:8; Num. 28:16–25; Deut. 16:8.

⁶ Fiftieth day from the Wave Sheaf Offering. Ex. 23:16, 34:22; Lev. 23:15–16; Deut. 16:9. Note: The Siwan date will also change with the Gregorian date from year to year.

⁷ First day of seventh month. Lev. 23:23–25; Num. 29:1.

⁸ Tenth day of seventh month. A day of fasting. Lev. 16:29–31, 23:26–32; Num. 29:7.

⁹ The first day of the eight-day Festival of Ingathering. This day along with the next six, which make up the first seven days of the Festival of Ingathering, are also referred to as the Feast of Tabernacles. Ex. 23:16, 34:22; Lev. 23:33–39; Num. 29:12; Deut. 16:13; John 7:10.

¹⁰ The last day (Last Great Day) of the eight-day Festival of Ingathering. Also this day as well as the entire festival is referred to as the Feast of Ingathering. Ex. 23:16; Lev. 23:36, 23:39; Num. 29:35; Neh. 8:18; John 7:37.°
